

SUMMARY

The Health Zone Nurse Practitioner Led Clinic (HZNPLC) provides primary healthcare services to residents within London Middlesex and surrounding areas. We are currently looking to fill a .5 position working 37.5 hours in a 2 week period beginning August 2nd 2016 for a one year contract.

Purpose: With indirect supervision, and working as part of an interdisciplinary team, the Registered Nurse (RN) provides high quality professional nursing care to clients, consistent with the vision of the Health Zone Nurse Practitioner Led Clinic and the Standards of the College of Nurses of Ontario (CNO).

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- [Performs nursing assessments, nursing treatments, health education/counseling and other clinical activities according to CNO standards of practice for RNs.
- [Responsible for overseeing and administration of immunizations and associated programs offered at HZNPLC, in conjunction with other staff.
- [Responsible for ensuring that HZNPLC maintains the highest level of infection control practice in all areas.
- [Participates in prevention & chronic disease management through education, monitoring and instruction of self-management techniques.
- [Development of individual & group education programs targeting various topics such as chronic disease prevention and management, prenatal and infant wellness programs.
- [Integrates appropriate community resources in education processes.
- [Contributes to the development of program plans and develops, plans, implements, coordinates and evaluates assigned projects in consultation with other team members.
- [Writes or assists with grant proposals as required.
- [Supervises nursing students and participates in the education of other students.
- [Contributes where necessary to evaluation processes and analysis of data
- [Records all visits appropriately in Electronic Medical Records in accordance with HZNPLC policies and CNO standards.

Specific Duties

- [Maintains and monitors appropriate stock of all vaccines
- [Performs immunizations of clients, as assigned
- [Organizes and runs immunization programs such as Flu clinics
- [Oversees infection control and ensures clinic is following appropriate infection control practices
- [Oversees proper autoclave procedure
- [Other clinical duties as assigned including B/P monitoring, Vitamin B12 injections, allergy desensitization
- [Well baby visits, as assigned
- [Programs such as SMART Start for babies, Smoking Cessation Support, Spirometry and others
- [Maintaining anaphylaxis cart and supplies; checking of oxygen tank and supplies monthly
- [Home visits as assigned
- [Other duties as assigned
