

Health Zone Nurse Practitioner-Led Clinic Nurse Practitioner Lead (Full-time)

Located in London, Ontario, the Health Zone Nurse Practitioner Led Clinic (NPLC) provides comprehensive primary health care to those who have limited access to care at 2 clinics and a Community Program Centre, as well as outreach sites. Our mandate is to provide health services to women, children, and their families, who live in marginalized conditions, are in transition, and who encounter barriers to accessing health or social care. Working collaboratively with our interprofessional team, you will share leadership responsibilities with the Administrative Lead for ensuring that the clinic's programs, services and policies evolve in ways, which reflect our Mission, Vision and Values.

Leadership and a passion for providing high quality, equity-oriented health care to the clients we seek to serve. You will develop and offer authentic leadership, mentoring and provide clinical support to a dynamic inter-professional health team. A forward thinker, the NP Lead is the primary contact for clinical practice issues with staff, consulting physicians, community partners and other groups. As a clinical leader, he/she will provide clinical supervision and mentoring to clinical staff and advance the mission, vision and values of the clinic by supporting the development of innovative and impactful programs and services. As a primary health care provider, the NP Lead practices within the scope of the Primary Health Care NP role and according to The College of Nurses of Ontario standards of practice. Together with the Administrative Lead, you will be responsible to the Board of Directors and oversee the core clinical programs.

- Superior interpersonal, communication, organizational, negotiation, and problem-solving skills;
