Primary Care Nurse Practitioner

Health Zone Nurse Practitioner Led Clinic (HZNPLC) provides primary healthcare services to residents within London, Ontario.

Our Vision is to improve the health equity and well-being of individuals and families. We provide effective, timely accessible primary health care services for individuals and families who encounter barriers to health or social care.

We are currently looking to fill a **temporary 1.0 FTE Nurse Practitioner** position, to cover a vacancy for 12 months commencing mid-February 2022 or earlier.

As a nurse practitioner at the Health Zone NPLC, you will be part of an interdisciplinary team of health and social service professionals providing high quality, accessible, timely, health care programs and services. You will be working to full NP scope as set out by the College of Nurses of Ontario, in the role of the Most Responsible Provider. You will engage in assessment, treatment/management, health education and promotion, advocacy, and service coordination/referral with a broad range of primary health care clients. As well, you will work in partnership with other community-based organizations, with clients, staff and students to ensure that services are responsive to diverse individual, family and community needs. You will participate in the education of NPs and inter-professional health sciences students, and in research and evaluation in order to improve the health of the clinic's primary care patients. You will maintain and develop professional competence by seeking out appropriate continuing education opportunities.

Qualifications:

- Primary Health Care Nurse Practitioner Certificate and current registration with the College of Nurses of Ontario in the extended class is required along with evidence of liability insurance;
- A minimum of 3 years clinical nursing experience, and at least one year of clinical experience as a NP-PHC, with preference given to candidates who have

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recent experience in primary care/community health, mental health, women's health, and chronic disease management;

- Advanced knowledge and skills in current, evidenced based practices in primary care delivery with an emphasis on health promotion, risk reduction and injury prevention;
- Committed to working within an inter-professional collaborative, strengths-based, health promotion framework to address the barriers faced by marginalized populations is essential; previous experience working with marginalized populations is an asset;
- Self-motivated, flexible and creative approach to work and stimulated by taking on new challenges;
- Excellent interpersonal, communication, organizational, negotiation, and problem-solving skills;
- Knowledge of electronic patient records, specifically experience with Telus PS Suites is an asset;• Current CPR certification and proficient with basic computer applications (word processing, email, internet searching, spreadsheets);
- Ability to work flexible hours;
- Possess a valid driver's license and access to personal insured vehicle;
- Competency in French and/or another language is an asset;
- Proof of routine immunizations, including complete vaccination against COVID-19 required;
- A vulnerable sector screen will be required prior to employment.
